PERFORMANCE SUGGESTIONS:

Envisioned for the beginning of an Easter service, this anthem can serve as a brief introit or as an introduction to the hymn "Jesus Christ Is Risen Today," sung to the tune *EASTER HYMN*. If used as an introduction, on completion move directly into the first stanza of the hymn.

The impact of the piece will be significantly enhanced if the trumpets begin apart from each other and in remote locations, moving closer during measures 9-12 (perhaps into the sanctuary or performance space), and moving into final position during measures 25-41.

Organ part in measures 1-25 is for rehearsal only.
